BACKGROUND

Challenges and changes are the two dynamics in Agriculture production system. Rhizosphere to biosphere affects the crops, its produce and products. Changing food habits, lifestyle is demanding a new dimension of thought process in planning agriculture for next decade.

Society of Krishi Vigyan (SKV), Amritsar, Punjab

The Society of Krishi Vigyan was formed and registered in December, 2013 at the KVK, Kapurthala, Punjab with an objective to disseminate the knowledge of agriculture and allied fields through meetings, discussions, seminars, conferences and publications. Likewise, to provide suitable forum to diffuse scientific knowledge among scientists and to facilitate personal contacts among scientists working in different parts of the country. The Society has its own website (www.iskv.in) for showcasing it's activities in order to broadcast its activities, recent events and uploading of all published volumes of Journal of Krishi Vigyan (NAAS rating 4.95 w.e.f.

01.01.2024). Initially, 32 scientists came together at SKUAST, Srinagar and founded the Society of Krishi Vigyan.

Later on, provision for life member was started and at present there are 612 life members across the country. The First National conference was organized by the Society at CIFA, Bhubaneswar in January, 2018, Second conference was held in virtual mode for 3 days in September, 2020 and the Third National conference was organized in collaboration with Rajmata Vijaya Raje Scindia Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya Gwalior in Ujjain during 17-20 October, 2022. It is worth to mention that during last 11 years; the Society has brought out 11 volumes of the Journal of Krishi Vigyan besides three special issues of the Journal for the benefit of scientists.

Jawaharlal Nehru Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya, Jabalpur

Jawaharlal Nehru Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya (JNKVV), Jabalpur (MP) was established on 1st October, 1964, by the Government of Madhya Pradesh. JNKVV is a State Agricultural University, implementing government funded research projects for agricultural development in the State of Madhya Pradesh. With the assistance of the State Government established the biggest multicampus university at Jabalpur, in the heart of India, named after the architect of modern India, Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru based on the recommendations of Radhakrishnan Commission (1949) on the concept of Establishment of Agricultural University. The Central Administrative Office of the University is located about 7 km North of Jabalpur town on National Highway 7. The University is serving 26 districts of Madhya Pradesh through 8 Colleges of Agriculture (Jabalpur, Rewa, Tikamgarh, Ganjbasoda, Powarkheda, Waraseoni, Khurai and Panna); two Colleges of Horticulture (Rehli and Chhindwara); one College of Agricultural Engineering (Jabalpur); one Horticultural Vocational Education Institute and Dryland Horticultural Research & Training Centre (Garhakota, Sagar), 4 Zonal Agricultural Research Stations (Jabalpur, Powarkheda, Tikamgarh and Chhindwara), 4 Regional Agricultural Research Stations (Rewa, Sagar, Dindori and Waraseoni), 4 Agricultural Research Stations (Naugaon, Garahakota, Sousar and Tendini) and 20 Krishi Vigyan Kendras (Jabalpur, Chhindwara, Sagar, Damoh, Panna, Betul, Rewa, Singrauli, Harda, Shahdol, Annupur, Umaria, Katni, Narsinghpur, Badgaon, Seoni, Tikamgarh, Chhatarpur, Mandla, and Dindori), spread over seven agro-climatic Zones. The University has been bestowed with Sardar Patel outstanding ICAR Institution Award-2018 by Indian Council of Agricultural Research, New Delhi.

ABOUT JABALPUR

Jabalpur, is a city situated on the banks of Narmada River in the state of Madhya Pradesh, India. Jabalpur is an important administrative, industrial and business centre of Madhya Pradesh. It is

the judicial capital of Madhya Pradesh as The Madhya Pradesh High Court along with other important administrative headquarters of India and Madhya Pradesh are located in Jabalpur. The city is known for the marble rocks on the river Narmada at Bhedaghat. Jabalpur has a humid subtropical climate typical of north-central India (Madhya Pradesh and southern Uttar Pradesh). Winter begins in late November and lasts until early March. January is the coldest month, with an average daily temperature near 15 °C. Summer begins in late March, lasting until June. May is the hottest month, with an average temperature exceeding 40 °C. The city is well connected by Rail, Road and Air. JNKVV campus is about 10 km away from Railway station (Jabalpur Junction), 8 km from Deen Dayal Bus Stand and 20 km from Jabalpur Airport.

Jabalpur is an important tourism city in Madhya Pradesh and central India. Notable sites in Jabalpur include Hanumantal, Bada Jain Mandir, Jabalpur Madan Mahal, Dhuandhar Falls, Chausath-Yogini, Gwarighat and Marble Rocks in Bhedaghat, Balancing rock near Madan Mahal Fort and the Shiv Statue at Kachnar City. The world-renowned tiger reserves like Kanha National Park, Bandhavgarh National Park, and Pench National Park can be easily visited via Jabalpur. The largest Wildlife Sanctuary in terms of area of the state of Madhya Pradesh, the Nauradehi Wildlife Sanctuary is very close to Jabalpur and can be easily visited. The recently notified Veerangana Durgavati Tiger Reserve which is the seventh tiger reserve in Madhya Pradesh also lies in close vicinity to Jabalpur and can be easily visited via Jabalpur.

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS/ FULL PAPERS

The abstracts/ full papers are invited on abovementioned themes of the conference. Papers should be based on the original research, and field experiences focusing on relevant themes. Review/ Data based papers, case studies and development experiences of individuals and organizations may also be accepted. Soft copy of the abstract (about 300 words) and full paper (about 4000-5000 words, 12 font size, double spacing) typed in Times New Roman font, having 25 mm margin from all sides in MS-Word format may be sent to e-mail id: ncskv2024jnkvv@gmail.com. The abstracts/ full papers indicating "Theme Number" on top right corner of the title page along with Delegate Registration Form shall be submitted via email on the conference e-mail id: ncskv2024jnkvv@gmail.com.

The abstract should contain a brief account of problem statement (100 Words), methodology (100 words), results and implications (100 words). The title of the abstract should preferably be less than 15 words, authors' names and affiliations and the email of the corresponding author.

The posters should not exceed the dimensions 30 x 40 inch and furnished with title, authors name, affiliation, introduction, materials and methods, results & discussion; and conclusion. A clear picture, diagrams, graphs and short tables are highly encouraged to use in poster to win the best poster award in each thematic area.

PUBLICATION

Experts from the Plenary speeches, Keynote addresses, invited talks, theme lectures and oral presentations will be published in the peer reviewed "Journal of Krishi Vigyan" of the Society of Krishi Vigyan in a special issue being brought out for the Conference.

VENUE OF THE CONFERENCE

The inaugural function of the Conference will be held at Sardar Ballabh Bhai Auditorium, College of Agriculture, Jabalpur and technical sessions will be conducted at Institute of Agri Business Management and Directorate of Extension Services, JNKVV Jabalpur, MP.
